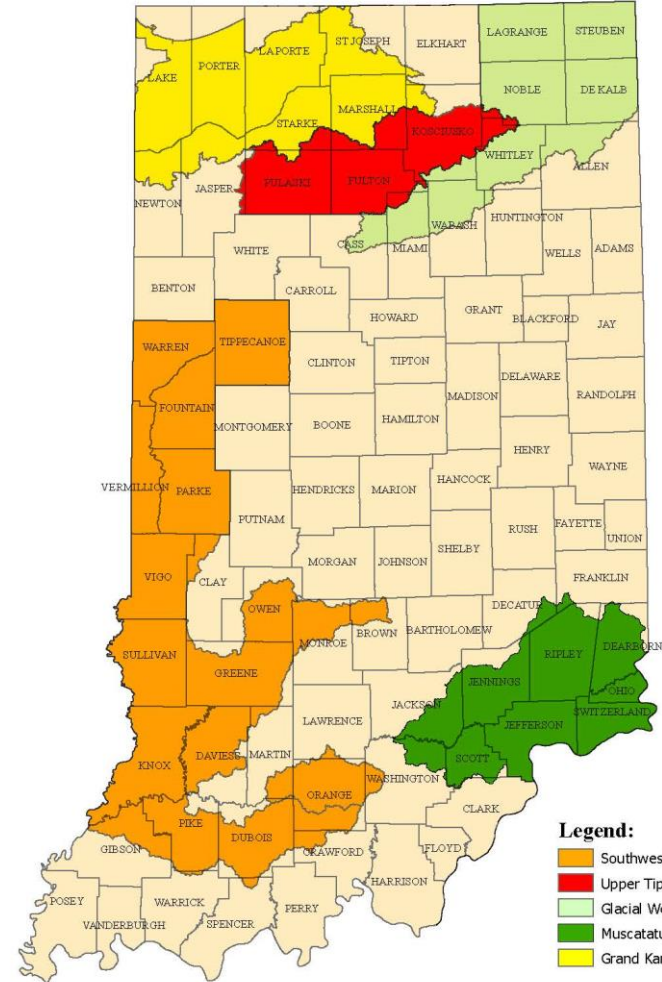

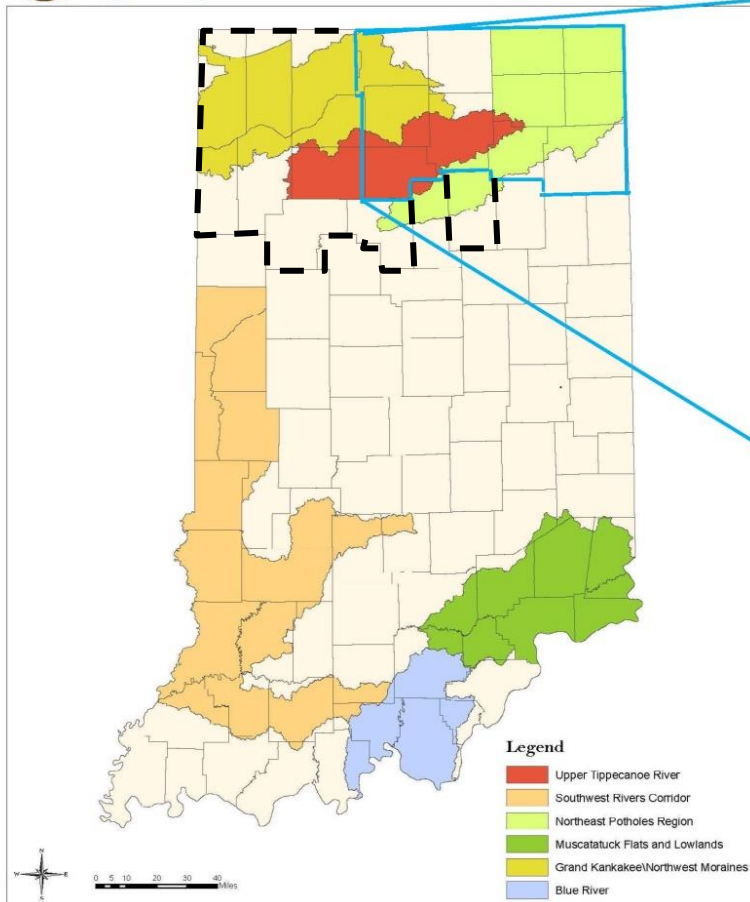


Partners for Fish and Wildlife Program – General Criteria

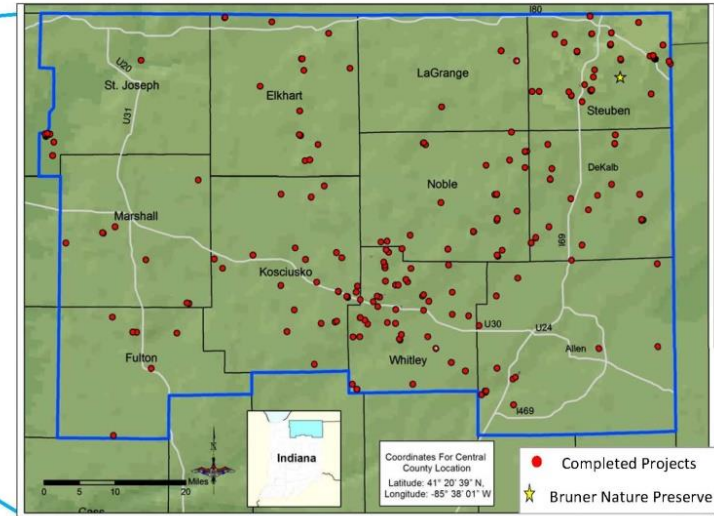
- *Private and local/county public lands eligible (e.g. individuals, NGOs, land trusts, corporate lands, parks)*
- *Projects must benefit Federal Trust Resources (e.g. migratory birds, T&E species, pollinators, NWR lands)*
- *Emphasis on PFW geographic focus areas (some flexibility)*
- *No cropping history required – 5 ac. min. size for grasslands (except for schools/educational sites); can be smaller for other habitat types*
- *10-year minimum landowner agreements (15-yr for trees)*
- *Typically 50-100% cost-share on avg. (depending on other funding partners involved)*
- *Varying options for providing cost-share*

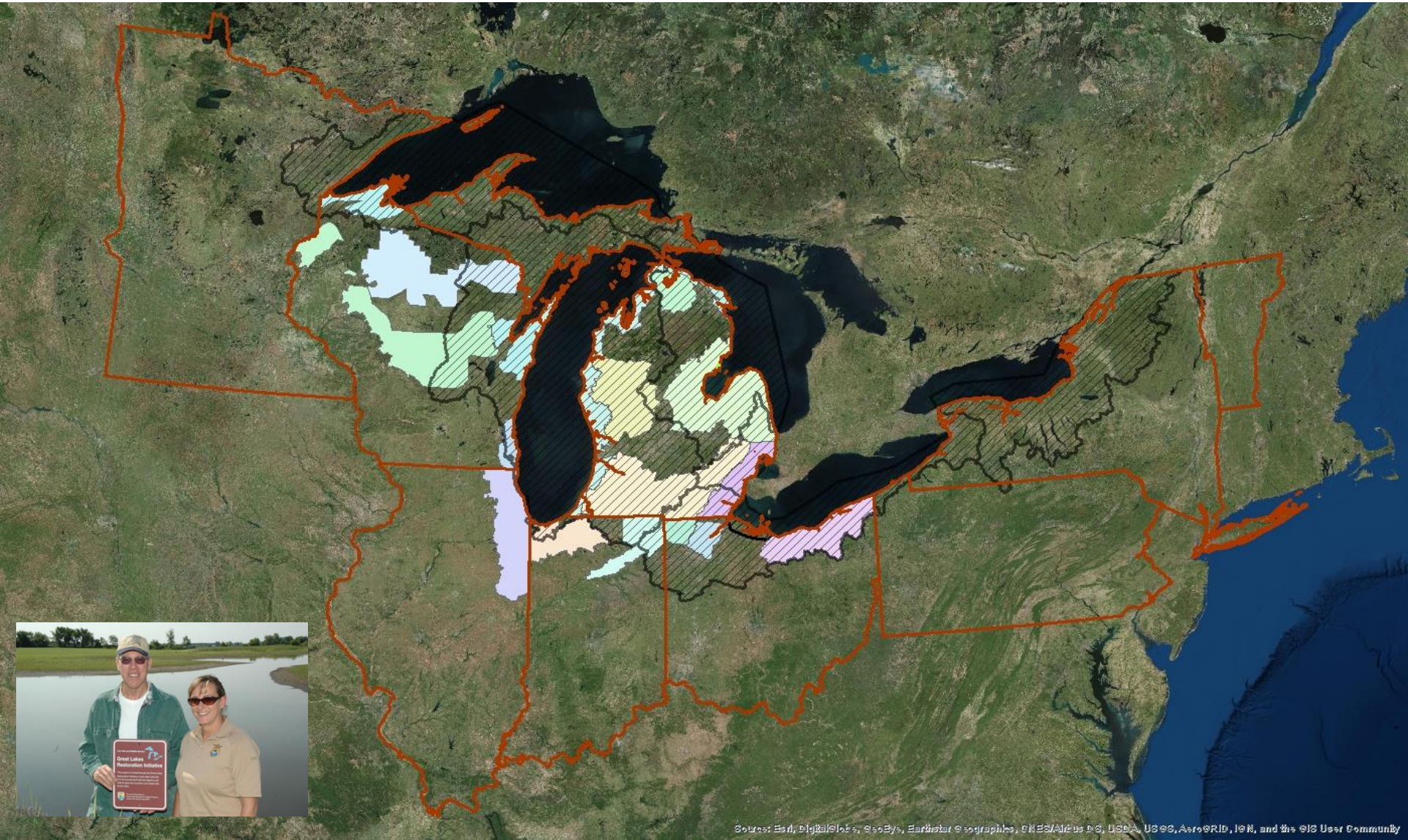
Northeast Indiana Wetland/Grassland Restoration Project

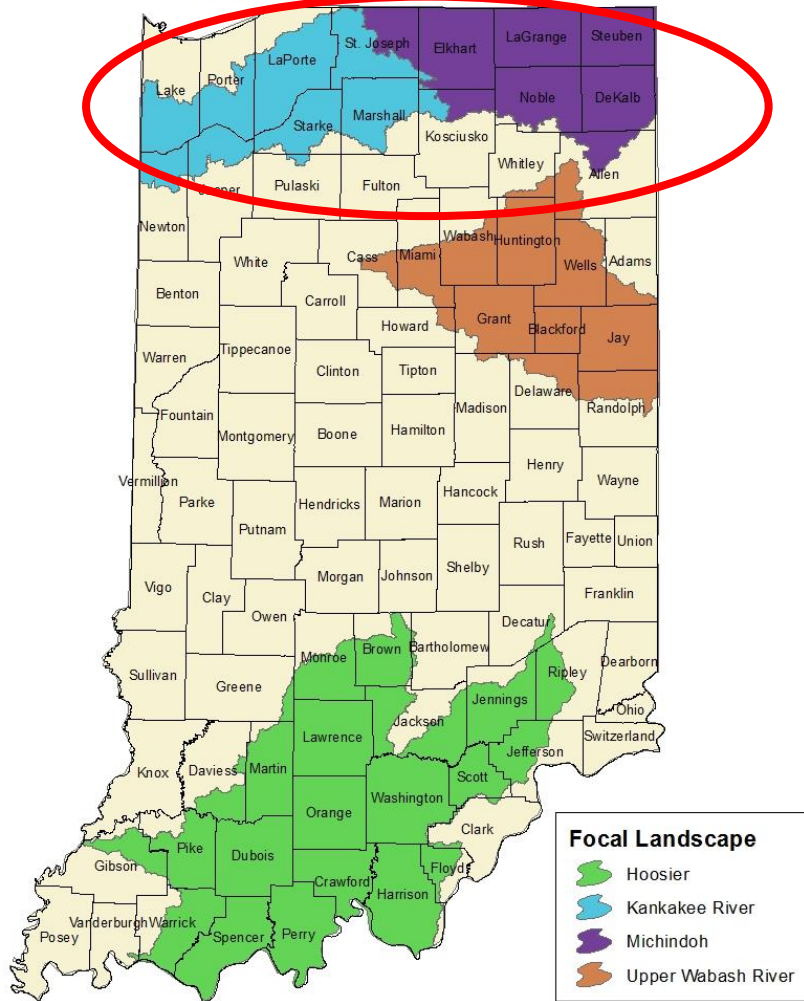




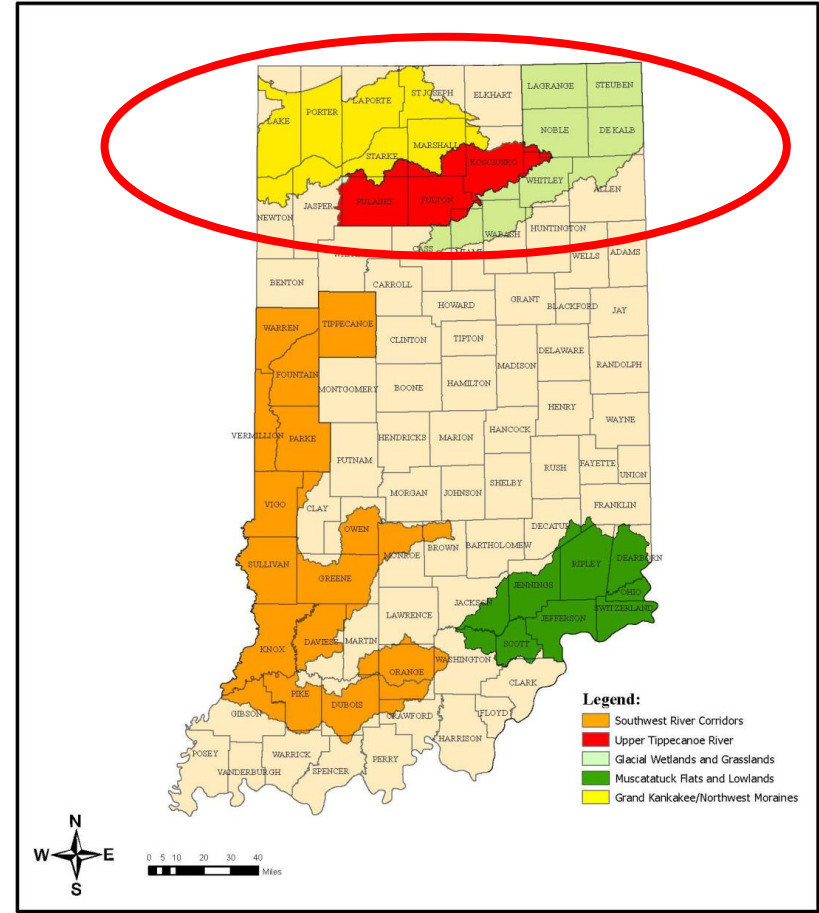
NWTF/USFWS MOU Focal Areas
