In addition, Farmers & Agribusiness Technical Assistance Provider will be comfortable navigating websites and data entry/program enrollment online forms using a cell phone, iPad, tablet or laptop computer, and has demonstrated experience in keeping electronic data records.

Scope of work:

This is an opportunity to share your 4R and soil health knowledge and expertise with other farmers seeking help and funding. You will have access to trainings, data and information.

- Promote programs and technical assistance training available like 4R Nutrient Management Certification and Farmers for Soil Health.
- Respond to landowner inquiries about nutrient management, cover crop, and soil health management.
- Assist landowners in enrolling for Farmers for Soil Health financial assistance.
- Maintain working knowledge of other programs and technical assistance available to farmers
- Option to attend farmer workshops, field days and virtual meetings.
- Maintain accurate records of farmer engagement numbers.
- Provide technical assistance and training to agribusiness participants.

This is a contracted position eligible for renewal annually through April 30, 2027.
