First Session of the 124th Indiana General Assembly

Legislators had hoped to finish the two-budget session next Thursday, a week early from the April 29 deadline, however the new revenue forecast issued last Wednesday caused them to scramble to rework HB1001 State Budget. They will need to reconsider spending plans due to an over [\\$2.4 Billion decrease in projected revenue](#) to already tight budget crafted over the past few weeks. It predicted the state's revenue will flatline from 2025 to 2027.

Governor Braun has signed 110 bills so far and the bills of interest on our tracker listed as HEA (House Enrolled Act) and SEA (Senate Enrolled Act) have been signed into law. Waiting for him are 1037, 1616, 1557 and 459 which have been concurred, on his desk for action. HB1460 Drainage systems is now scheduled for Conference Committee to work on changes.
