April 25, 2025 IASWCD (Final) Bill Tracker

First Session of the 124th Indiana General Assembly

After 107 days since convening and considering 1257 bills, the General Assembly adjourned in the early morning hours Friday with a rush of votes to complete a new two-year budget. 181 bills have now made it to Governor Braun's desk for his decision (see link below). With last day spending cuts and revenue increases such as in increase of \$2 on cigarettes, legislators finished a week early. **Our CWI line item stayed at \$6 Million and we are watching to see what impact the cigarette tax increase will have on our other line.** ISDA, as with many agencies, will need to cut 5% and operate under tight restrictions. Indiana plans to spend nearly \$45 Billion in 2025-27.

Enrolled acts signed by the Speaker of the House and the President Pro Tempore are sent to the Office of the Lt. Governor for signature, are then returned to the Office of the Secretary of the Senate (for Senate Enrolled Acts) or the Clerk of the House of Representatives (for House Enrolled Acts), and then go to the Office of the Governor. From there, the Governor reviews all legislation and has seven days to sign or veto the bill. If he does not sign it, it automatically becomes law on the eighth day after receipt.
